



**East Mississippi Community College
Tuition Guarantee Program
Fall Semester 2009**

Tuition Guarantee is a program which covers the cost of tuition for eligible students to attend East Mississippi Community College. Tuition Guarantee is a maximum of the cost of tuition less federal and state aid and EMCC scholarships, and is for a maximum period of four (4) consecutive semesters, excluding summers.

In order to be eligible for the Tuition Guarantee Program, a student must meet the following requirements:

- Must be a resident of EMCC's six-county district – Lowndes, Clay, Oktibbeha, Noxubee, Kemper or Lauderdale.
- Must be a graduate of an accredited high school in the EMCC district in May 2009 or later.
- Must apply for all Federal and State aid and any applicable EMCC Scholarships.
- Must register full-time, twelve (12) or more semester credit hours, in the fall following graduation from high school.
- Must maintain a minimum of twelve (12) semester credit hours each semester. If enrollment drops below twelve (12) semester credit hours at any time, the student will lose tuition guarantee funding and will be ineligible for the tuition guarantee program from that point on.
- Must maintain a 2.0 GPA.

Students who graduated prior to May 2009 are not eligible for tuition guarantee.

Students who transfer from other colleges are not eligible for tuition guarantee.

Students who enroll in programs that are not approved for financial aid are not eligible for tuition guarantee.

Continuation of the Tuition Guarantee Program is contingent on funding.
